



ICtelecom lists on NYSE Alternext

Paris, 28 May 2010 – NYSE Euronext today announced the transfer of ICtelecom from the Free Market to NYSE Alternext.

A full-service telecom integrator and operator, ICtelecom offers IP-based telephony solutions meeting the needs of entrepreneurs and SMEs. The company provides clients with expert advice and ongoing support to develop and optimize their infrastructure, from fixed lines to portable devices, aiming for effective convergence of telecom tools.

ICtelecom (ticker symbol: ALICT) was admitted by listing of the 1,796,103 existing shares making up its capital. The transfer of shares from the Free Market to NYSE Alternext was associated with the issue of 1,796,103 stock warrants, simultaneously admitted to NYSE Alternext and allotted free of charge to existing shareholders. The potential capital increase, assuming the exercise of all these stock warrants, amounts to approximately €5.4 million.

In connection with ICtelecom's transfer to NYSE Alternext, financial market supervisor AMF set its visa n° 10-134 on the Prospectus on 18 May 2010 and its visa n° 10-140 on the Supplement to the Prospectus on 21 May 2010.

The market capitalization of ICtelecom on the date of admission amounted to €12.39 million.

"We are delighted with ICtelecom's transfer to NYSE Alternext and very happy to be able to provide support for the business development and innovative projects of this company in the promising telecoms convergence market, comments Ronald Kent, Group Executive Vice President and Head of International Listings at NYSE Euronext. This new listing illustrates NYSE Euronext's capacity to offer businesses a market and a comprehensive range of backup services that keep step with their needs and ambitions."

Goel Haddouk, Chairman and CEO of ICtelecom, adds: *"Since joining the Free Market in June 2007, ICtelecom has posted rapid growth, with sales reaching €15.70 million in the 2008-2009 financial year. Our transfer to NYSE Alternext is in full keeping with the dynamics of our strategy. It will mean higher market visibility, benefiting all of our current shareholders, and enable us to call on a broader investor base to support expansion on our high-growth market."*

NYSE Alternext, which has just celebrated its fifth year in operation, today counts 136 listed companies from countries including Belgium, Canada, China, France, Italy, Luxembourg, the Netherlands, Spain, the UK and the US. They have raised over €2.3 billion altogether, half of this through secondary issues, and their market capitalization totals €4.4 billion.
